

OFFICIAL RULES

1. CONTEST PERIOD, SPONSOR, AND DEFINITIONS

The Raise Your Voice Challenge (the "Contest") is sponsored and administered by Dear Jack Foundation, Inc. (the "Sponsor") for the benefit of Dear Jack Foundation and its charitable mission.

The Contest begins on Friday, August 21, 2026, at 12:00 p.m. Mountain Time and ends on Saturday, November 14, 2026, at 11:59 p.m. Mountain Time (the "Contest Period"). Unless otherwise stated in these Official Rules, Sponsor's records and the official records of the designated GoFundMe Pro fundraising campaign shall determine the timing and amount of all eligible fundraising activity.

For purposes of these Official Rules:

- **Participant** means an eligible individual who creates and publishes a fundraising page through the official Dear Jack Foundation Raise Your Voice Challenge campaign.
- **Team** means two or more Participants fundraising together through a GoFundMe Pro Team.
- **Eligible Donation** means a donation that Sponsor determines qualifies under these Official Rules and is credited toward a Participant's or Team's fundraising total. Sponsor reserves the right to determine whether any donation qualifies as an Eligible Donation and to reconcile, adjust, or remove donations that are fraudulent, refunded, duplicated, improperly credited, or otherwise inconsistent with these Official Rules.
- **Board Member** means an individual serving on the Dear Jack Foundation Board of Directors at any time during the Contest Period.

Sponsor reserves the right to make reasonable administrative decisions necessary to accurately administer the Contest, resolve questions regarding fundraising totals, and interpret these Official Rules. Sponsor's decisions shall be final and binding except where prohibited by law.

2. ELIGIBILITY

The Contest is open to individuals who are at least eighteen (18) years of age at the time of entry and who reside in the continental United States. Participation is voluntary and void where prohibited or restricted by law.

Only individuals may participate in the Contest. Commercial enterprises, businesses, organizations, and other legal entities are not eligible to enter as Participants, although they may make donations in support of Participants or Teams in accordance with these Official Rules.

Employees of Dear Jack Foundation are not eligible to participate in the Contest or receive prizes.

Dear Jack Foundation also reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to determine that any individual or category of individuals is ineligible to participate in the Contest or receive prizes if the Foundation reasonably believes that such participation creates, or could reasonably be perceived as creating, an actual or apparent conflict of interest or otherwise compromises the integrity of the Contest. Sponsor's determination shall be final and binding.

Current members of the Dear Jack Foundation Board of Directors are permitted to participate in the Contest. Board Members may participate as Individual Participants, create or join Teams, and all Eligible

Donations credited to a Board Member during the Contest Period will count toward both the Board Member's individual fundraising total and the fundraising total of any Team of which the Board Member is a member.

However, Board Members are not eligible to receive individual fundraising prizes, including the Individual Grand Prize or any Individual Tier Prize. If a Board Member would otherwise qualify for an individual prize, that prize will instead be awarded to the next highest-ranking eligible non-Board Member.

Teams that include one or more Board Members remain fully eligible to compete for and receive Team Prizes. All Eligible Donations credited to participating Board Members will be included when calculating the Team's final fundraising total.

By participating in the Contest, each Participant represents that the Participant satisfies the eligibility requirements contained in these Official Rules, agrees to comply with and be bound by these Official Rules, and agrees to abide by Sponsor's decisions regarding eligibility and administration of the Contest.

Sponsor reserves the right to verify eligibility at any time and to disqualify any Participant who provides false or misleading information, attempts to manipulate fundraising totals, violates these Official Rules, or otherwise acts in a manner that Sponsor reasonably determines compromises the fairness, integrity, or charitable purpose of the Contest.

3. HOW TO ENTER

An eligible individual may enter the Contest by creating and publishing an individual fundraising page through the official Dear Jack Foundation Raise Your Voice Challenge GoFundMe Pro campaign during the Contest Period. A Participant's fundraising page must be fully activated and publicly accessible in order to constitute a valid entry.

Participants may fundraise individually, create a Team, or join an existing Team, subject to any deadlines established by Sponsor. Unless otherwise announced by Sponsor, a Participant may join a Team until September 15, 2026, at 11:59 p.m. Mountain Time.

Participation in the Contest is free. No purchase or donation is required to create a fundraising page or become a Participant.

Each Participant is responsible for ensuring that all information submitted in connection with the Contest is accurate and complete. Sponsor reserves the right to reject, suspend, or remove any fundraising page or Participant that Sponsor reasonably determines violates these Official Rules, applicable law, the charitable mission of Dear Jack Foundation, or the terms and conditions of the fundraising platform.

All fundraising activity must be conducted honestly, ethically, and in accordance with applicable law. Participants may not misrepresent the Foundation, make misleading statements regarding the use of charitable funds, or engage in fraudulent, deceptive, or manipulative fundraising practices.

4. DETERMINATION OF WINNERS

Following the conclusion of the Contest Period, Sponsor will review and reconcile all Eligible Donations received during the Contest Period before determining final fundraising totals.

The **Individual Grand Prize Winner** will be the eligible Participant (excluding current Board Members) with the highest verified individual fundraising total during the Contest Period.

The **Team Grand Prize Winner** will be the eligible Team with the highest verified Team fundraising total during the Contest Period.

Individual fundraising totals and Team fundraising totals shall be determined solely from Eligible Donations credited by Sponsor. Sponsor reserves the right to review, verify, adjust, or remove any donation that Sponsor reasonably determines was credited in error, is fraudulent, violates these Official Rules, or otherwise should not be included in Contest results.

Sponsor expects to notify potential winners on or before December 31, 2026. Potential winners are not considered official winners until Sponsor has verified eligibility, confirmed compliance with these Official Rules, and completed any documentation Sponsor reasonably requires to administer the Contest or fulfill prizes.

If a potential winner is found to be ineligible, declines a prize, cannot be contacted after reasonable efforts, fails to complete required documentation, or otherwise fails to satisfy these Official Rules, Sponsor may award the applicable prize to the next highest-ranking eligible Participant or Team.

In the event of a tie, Sponsor will apply the tie-breaking procedure published by Sponsor prior to the start of the Contest. If no such procedure has been published, Sponsor will determine the winner using a fair and reasonable method designed to preserve the integrity of the Contest.

Sponsor's determination of fundraising totals, eligibility, prize qualification, and Contest winners shall be final and binding.

5. FUNDRAISER APPRECIATION RAFFLE

In addition to the fundraising competition, eligible Participants will automatically receive entries into the Fundraiser Appreciation Raffle.

Participants will receive one (1) raffle entry for every one hundred dollars (\$100.00 USD) in Eligible Donations credited to their individual fundraising page during the Contest Period. Eligible Donations shall be rounded down to the nearest one hundred dollars for purposes of calculating raffle entries.

Raffle drawings will be conducted on or before January 1, 2027.

Winning entries will be selected at random from among all eligible raffle entries received. Odds of winning depend upon the total number of eligible raffle entries earned during the Contest Period.

A Participant may win more than one raffle prize unless Sponsor announces otherwise prior to the drawing.

Potential raffle winners will be notified using the contact information associated with their fundraising account and must satisfy all eligibility requirements contained in these Official Rules before a prize will be awarded.

If a selected raffle winner is determined to be ineligible, declines the prize, cannot be contacted after reasonable efforts, or fails to satisfy these Official Rules, Sponsor may select an alternate winner.

6. PRIZES

The prizes described below are intended to recognize outstanding fundraising efforts in support of Dear Jack Foundation. Sponsor reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value if circumstances beyond Sponsor's reasonable control make a listed prize unavailable.

Individual Grand Prize

The eligible Participant who raises the highest verified individual fundraising total during the Contest Period will receive one (1) midship cabin for two (2) guests aboard the next Sixthman Holiday From Real Cruise headlined by Andrew McMahon, currently anticipated for Spring 2028, subject to availability and the policies of Sixthman. Additional prize details, including cabin category, approximate retail value, booking requirements, and any applicable restrictions, will be announced once confirmed. Additionally, \$500 will be provided towards on board expenses or otherwise affiliated costs.

The Grand Prize does not include transportation to or from the port, hotels, meals outside those included by the cruise operator, gratuities, travel insurance, personal expenses, or any other costs not specifically identified by Sponsor.

If the cruise is cancelled, materially modified, or otherwise becomes unavailable, Sponsor reserves the right to substitute another prize of equal or greater value.

Team Grand Prize

The Team with the highest verified fundraising total during the Contest Period will receive a private Zac Clark living room performance for up to ten (10) guests.

The performance will be scheduled during 2027 or 2028 at a mutually agreeable date, time, and location, subject to artist availability, scheduling, travel considerations, and other logistical requirements determined by Sponsor.

The winning Team will also receive one (1) virtual happy hour with Andrew McMahon and representatives of Dear Jack Foundation, subject to scheduling availability.

Individual Tier Awards

In addition to the Individual Grand Prize, eligible Participants who achieve the following fundraising milestones will receive the corresponding recognition awards:

\$5,000 or more

- Limited Edition Dear Jack Foundation T-shirt
- Dear Jack Foundation travel mug or water bottle

\$10,000 or more

- All lower-tier awards
- \$100 merchandise credit for Andrew McMahon merchandise (details to be finalized)
- Dear Jack Foundation merchandise bundle

\$20,000 or more

- All lower-tier awards
- Framed, signed setlist from the November 13 or November 14, 2026, Boettcher Hall Symphony performances

Sponsor expects to fulfill Individual Tier Awards by March 15, 2027.

General Prize Terms

All prizes are non-transferable unless expressly authorized by Sponsor.

Winners are solely responsible for all federal, state, and local taxes associated with acceptance of any prize.

Sponsor reserves the right to require winners to execute reasonable affidavits, releases, tax forms, or other documentation prior to prize fulfillment.

Prizes may not be substituted or redeemed for cash unless expressly provided by Sponsor or required by applicable law.

7. CONDITIONS, RELEASES, AND WINNER VERIFICATION

By participating in the Contest, each Participant agrees to comply with these Official Rules and all decisions of Dear Jack Foundation regarding the administration of the Contest. Sponsor's decisions concerning eligibility, fundraising totals, prize qualification, winner selection, interpretation of these Official Rules, and all other Contest matters shall be final and binding, except where prohibited by applicable law.

As a condition of receiving any prize, Sponsor may require a potential winner to complete and return an Affidavit of Eligibility, Liability Release, Publicity Release (where permitted by law), IRS tax documentation, or any other documentation reasonably necessary to verify eligibility, comply with applicable law, or facilitate prize fulfillment.

Sponsor reserves the right to verify any Participant's eligibility, fundraising activity, or compliance with these Official Rules at any time. Sponsor may investigate any activity that it reasonably believes to be fraudulent, deceptive, inconsistent with the charitable purpose of the Contest, or otherwise in violation of these Official Rules.

If Sponsor determines that a Participant has engaged in fraud, attempted to manipulate fundraising totals, knowingly submitted false information, violated these Official Rules, or otherwise acted in a manner that compromises the fairness or integrity of the Contest, Sponsor may disqualify the Participant, remove ineligible donations from Contest totals, revoke prize eligibility, or take any combination of such actions.

Participants agree to release, indemnify, and hold harmless Dear Jack Foundation, its officers, directors, employees, volunteers, agents, contractors, sponsors, partners, successors, assigns, and any individuals or organizations assisting in the administration of the Contest (collectively, the "Released Parties") from and against any claims, damages, liabilities, losses, costs, or expenses arising out of or relating to:

- (a) participation in the Contest;
- (b) fundraising activities conducted by the Participant;
- (c) acceptance, possession, use, misuse, or inability to use any prize;
- (d) travel associated with any prize or Contest-related activity;
- (e) any acts or omissions of third-party vendors, artists, performers, venues, cruise operators, transportation providers, or other service providers; or
- (f) any violation of these Official Rules by the Participant.

Nothing in these Official Rules limits any rights that cannot legally be waived under applicable law.

If a potential winner fails to timely return required documentation, cannot be contacted after reasonable efforts, declines a prize, is determined to be ineligible, or otherwise fails to satisfy these Official Rules, Sponsor may declare that individual or Team ineligible and award the applicable prize to the next highest-ranking eligible Participant or Team, as applicable.

Sponsor reserves the right to require reasonable proof of identity, eligibility, fundraising activity, or other information necessary to administer the Contest or fulfill prizes.

8. PUBLICITY

Except where prohibited by law, acceptance of any prize constitutes the winner's permission for Dear Jack Foundation and its designees to use the winner's name, city and state of residence, likeness, photograph, voice, video, biographical information, fundraising story, and statements relating to the Contest or Dear Jack Foundation for promotional, educational, fundraising, or marketing purposes, in any media now known or later developed, worldwide and without additional compensation.

Sponsor is under no obligation to use any winner's name, likeness, or other materials.

If a prize includes a guest or travel companion, the winner is solely responsible for ensuring that such individual executes any releases, waivers, or other documentation reasonably required by Sponsor or the applicable prize provider.

Nothing in this Section limits any rights provided to Participants under applicable privacy laws.

9. GENERAL CONDITIONS

The integrity of the Raise Your Voice Challenge is of paramount importance to Dear Jack Foundation. Sponsor reserves the right to interpret and apply these Official Rules in a manner that preserves the fairness, charitable purpose, and integrity of the Contest.

Sponsor reserves the right to suspend, modify, postpone, or cancel all or any portion of the Contest if fraud, technical failures, platform outages, natural disasters, public health emergencies, acts of God, governmental action, security concerns, or any other event beyond Sponsor's reasonable control materially interferes with the administration of the Contest.

Sponsor may correct clerical, mathematical, technical, or administrative errors at any time, including errors affecting fundraising totals, prize descriptions, winner notifications, or published materials.

Sponsor reserves the right to disqualify any Participant or Team that:

- Violates these Official Rules;
- Attempts to manipulate fundraising totals or Contest results;
- Uses fraudulent, deceptive, or misleading fundraising practices;
- Interferes with the administration of the Contest;
- Uses automated methods, fake accounts, or other improper means to influence Contest results; or
- Acts in a manner that Sponsor reasonably determines is inconsistent with the charitable mission or reputation of Dear Jack Foundation.

If Sponsor determines that an ineligible donation or fundraising activity materially affected Contest results, Sponsor may adjust fundraising totals, disqualify the affected Participant or Team, recalculate rankings, or award prizes to another eligible Participant or Team.

Nothing in these Official Rules obligates Sponsor to continue, modify, or repeat the Contest in future years.

10. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Released Parties shall not be liable for any loss, injury, damage, delay, expense, or claim arising from or relating to:

- (a) participation in the Contest;
- (b) technical failures, interruptions, or malfunctions involving websites, fundraising platforms, computer systems, telecommunications systems, or internet services;
- (c) lost, late, incomplete, misdirected, corrupted, delayed, or inaccurate communications or fundraising data;

- (d) unauthorized access to, or alteration of, Contest information;
- (e) errors in the administration of the Contest;
- (f) cancellation, postponement, substitution, or modification of any prize or prize-related event;
- (g) acts or omissions of third-party vendors, performers, venues, cruise operators, transportation providers, hotels, or other service providers; or
- (h) acceptance, possession, use, misuse, or inability to use any prize.

Sponsor does not warrant that any website, fundraising platform, or Contest-related technology will operate without interruption or error.

Except where prohibited by law, Sponsor's total liability arising out of or relating to the Contest shall not exceed the value of the prize, if any, awarded to the affected Participant.

Some jurisdictions do not permit certain limitations of liability. Where prohibited by law, the foregoing limitations shall apply only to the maximum extent permitted.

11. GOVERNING LAW; DISPUTE RESOLUTION

Except where prohibited by applicable law, these Official Rules and the Contest shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of California, without regard to its conflict of law principles.

Any legal action arising out of or relating to the Contest or these Official Rules shall be brought exclusively in the state or federal courts located in Los Angeles County, California, and each Participant irrevocably consents to the jurisdiction and venue of such courts.

To the fullest extent permitted by law, Participants agree that any claim shall be brought solely in an individual capacity and not as a plaintiff or class member in any purported class, consolidated, or representative action.

Nothing contained in these Official Rules shall limit any rights or remedies that cannot legally be waived under applicable law.

12. OFFICIAL RULES

These Official Rules shall be posted on the official Raise Your Voice Challenge website throughout the Contest Period.

By participating in the Contest, each Participant acknowledges that they have had the opportunity to review these Official Rules and agree to be bound by them.

In the event of any inconsistency between promotional materials, frequently asked questions, social media posts, or other Contest communications and these Official Rules, these Official Rules shall control.

13. SPONSOR

The Raise Your Voice Challenge is sponsored and administered by:

Dear Jack Foundation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation recognized as tax-exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

14. RESERVATION OF RIGHTS

Dear Jack Foundation reserves the right to interpret, administer, and enforce these Official Rules in good faith and in a manner consistent with the charitable purpose and integrity of the Contest.

Sponsor further reserves the right to amend these Official Rules, correct administrative or clerical errors, substitute prizes of equal or greater value when reasonably necessary, and take any other action reasonably required to administer the Contest fairly and efficiently, provided that no such action materially prejudices the rights of Participants except as required by law or circumstances beyond Sponsor's reasonable control.

Nothing contained in these Official Rules shall be construed as creating any contractual obligation for Dear Jack Foundation to conduct future fundraising contests or award prizes beyond those expressly described herein.

15. PRIVACY

Information collected from Participants in connection with the Contest will be used for the purpose of administering the Contest, verifying eligibility, communicating with Participants, fulfilling prizes, complying with applicable law, maintaining Sponsor's business records, and carrying out Dear Jack Foundation's charitable mission.

By participating in the Contest, Participants acknowledge that their personal information may be collected, used, and disclosed in accordance with Dear Jack Foundation's Privacy Policy, as amended from time to time.

Participants may also receive future communications from Dear Jack Foundation regarding programs, fundraising initiatives, events, volunteer opportunities, and other organizational updates. Participants may opt out of marketing communications at any time using the unsubscribe instructions included in such communications or by contacting Dear Jack Foundation directly.

Sponsor will maintain Participant information in accordance with applicable privacy laws and commercially reasonable security practices.
